DEBT HELP AT THE LIBERTY TEA ROOMS

After 18 brilliant years of working with CAP, our Debt Help Centre is changing. From April 2024, we will become “Liberty Community Money Advice”, in affiliation with Community Money Advice (CMA). We will continue to offer practical budgeting help through CAP Money Coaching and CAP Life Skills, and we will also offer free, 1-1 Money Mentoring through our new partnership with Community Money Advice (CMA). This will still include debt help, just with a different client journey to our current offering. We will still partner with CAP to run CAP Money Coaching and CAP Life Skills.

What is changing ?

What will change is that our 1-1 support will still sit under the supervision and guidance of a Christian organisation, in the form of CMA. Our ‘Debt Help’ service will become ‘Money Mentoring’ – a broader service that will include debt help and give us more flexibility to meet our community’s needs. Clients will book with us directly, rather than through CAP’s Head Office. Clients’ first appointments will focus on ‘triaging’ their needs: identifying the challenges of their specific situation and working together to decide their next steps. Debt Advice will be provided through CMA’s “Hub”

How will the changeover work ?

We will see our last new CAP debt help clients in March 2024. All these appointments have already been booked up, so we are signposting new clients to Harpenden Money Advice as a temporary measure until our new service is up and running. From April to June, we will :

- Wrap up all ongoing debt help cases with CAP
- Set up the new Liberty Community Money Advice centre

We aim to open our new service from June 2024, but this is subject to change.

Community Money Advice (CMA) is a national charity committed to supporting churches and community groups who have a passion to help people overcome their money problems.
