CHRISTMAS – ALL CREATION SINGS; OF SHARING WARMTH

They all keep moving, tiny steps, so that they circle around & take turns to bear the brunt of the freezing wind. A remarkable collective consciousness. They perform this corporate dance together to survive the most hostile conditions. There's something for Carey to aspire to through this difficult winter... We will need more than Xmas jumpers...
